27TH ANNUAL ART SHOW

AGE DIVISIONS:

- Experienced: age 60–79
 - Masters: 80 plus
- (except creative woodworking — one age division)

ENTRY CRITERIA:

\$20.00 per entry is due upon submitting the artwork to cover rentals, insurance and handling fees. No more than two entries per artist may be submitted. The entry must have been completed within the last three years. Original pieces only. The following will not be allowed as an entry in the Art Show: no kit assembled products, no furniture, no carved jewelry, no decorative signage, no nude works, no commercially mass-produced items, no shadow boxes, and no pieces entered previously may be re-entered.

ENTRY AND RELEASE:

All entries, along with the Entry Form, will be accepted Monday, October 7 through Friday, October 11 between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. Entries must include a brief biographical profile and a release authorizing SDHCA to reproduce any winning entry for promotional purposes without compensation to the artist. The release form must be submitted with the entry and be on file prior to judging.

All non-winning entries are to be picked up within 30 days after the Sioux Falls show. Items not retrieved in 30 days following the show will be considered abandoned. Due to space restrictions, original packaging materials may not be returned. SDHCA suggests entrants take packaging with them when dropping off entries.

CREATIVE CATEGORIES:

First, Second and Third Place cash awards will be given in each category. In addition, judges will select a Best of Show. The public will also be invited to vote for the Legacy People's Choice award to be presented following the show. Categories and entry specifications are:

- Painting (oil)
• Painting (acrylic)
• Painting (watercolor)
Must be framed including flat screws and hanging wires. All paintings—size limited to no larger than 30" x 36" total including the frame, 2-dimensional only.
Note: Canvas does not need to be framed but does need flat screws and wires.
- Drawing/Pastels/Scratchboard
Must be framed including flat screws and hanging wires. Size limited to no larger than 30" x 36" total including the frame, 2-dimensional only.
- Photography (black and white or color)
Must be framed including flat screws and hanging wires. Size limited to no larger than 30" x 36" total including the frame, 2-dimensional only.
- Mixed Media
Must be framed including flat screws and hanging wires. Limited to a mixture of 2 or more of the following— Oil paint, acrylic paint, watercolor paint, pencils, scratchboard and photography (no shadow boxes). 2-dimensional only. Size limited to no larger than 30" x 36" total including the frame, 2-dimensional only.
- Creative Woodworking (2 categories, no separate age divisions for this medium)
Size limited to no larger than 14" x 24". Weight limited to no more than 5 lbs. For larger objects, a color photo may be substituted. No kits.
 - Woodcarving
Original 3-dimensional, relief, or whimsical woodcarvings.
 - Open Class
Original works including wood turning, intarsia, pyrography, and wood burning. Excluded: Pottery, ceramics, jewelry, furniture, and craft show signage (no kits or non-original patterns).

The event is open to every citizen of South Dakota who is age 60 and older. The SDHCA *Dakota MasterWorks* Art Show will take place at the Good Samaritan Society National Campus, 4800 W. 57th Street in Sioux Falls on November 7, 3 p.m.–7 p.m., and November 8, 10:30 a.m.–12:30 p.m. Winners in each category will be honored at an Awards Reception on November 7 at 7 p.m.

ENTRY SUBMISSIONS:

All entries must be within size and weight limitations unless pre-approved by the SDHCA *Dakota MasterWorks* Committee. Entries and artists may be featured in future SDHCA *Dakota MasterWorks* promotional materials and products. Therefore, all entries will require a release authorizing SDHCA *Dakota MasterWorks* or its assignees to utilize a reproduction of winning entries and an artist profile in promotional literature and materials. Promotional designs are left to the professional designers.

JUDGING:

Judging will take place in Sioux Falls prior to the exhibit. Judges are appointed based on their talent and expertise. Award categories are:

- Best of Show.
- First through Third Place in each age division and category, except creative woodworking (one age division).
- People's Choice Award—based on votes of those attending the exhibit.

AWARDS:

The First Place winners in each category will receive a check for \$75; Second Place, \$50, and Third Place, \$25. The Best of Show and Legacy People's Choice will each receive an award of \$100.

First, Second, Third, Best of Show and Legacy People's Choice winning entries will be exhibited at various sites in South Dakota through January 2025.
